- Minutes Approval - Motion to approve March minutes by Tammy Bresse, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dennis Stoddard
- No April minutes submitted yet by Jennifer Mustain**
- Treasurer Report - Dennis Stoddard**---April statement handed out. No comments or disagreements of April statement. All money from last three registrations deposited in account. There has been a difference in amount of deposit of checks from Dennis, his books do not agree with bank statement. He is clearing that up. Our B of A in Raley's has moved to Lemon Valley, no longer open at Raley's. No more night deposit at Raley's. Dennis has picked up new keys for night deposit at the new bank in Lemon Valley. Bank of America is no longer sending checks with monthly statement, National does not approve of that, so Dennis is clearing up that issue. We are also trying to refund Jennifer Mustain her money for coverage of her trip to Sections. Jennifer not present to accept check and give balance. We are still under our count in players registered for this season. More players needed to register to make budget for this season. Registration is now \$85.00. We hope to catch up.
- Public Relations-Carolyn Stoddard**---New flyer to be made up for the last registration. We will distribute to as many schools and other locations as we can. We talked about getting posters put up at local Stores bulletin boards. Shannon Owens is picking up big sign out of storage to put up for next registration on June 4<sup>th</sup>. It will be placed on Stead Blvd. at Silver Lake Rd., at stop light intersection.
- Registration---Tammy Bresse**---Registration went well. More players needed to make budget for this season. Almost all of registered players are registered into the eAYSO system. Still have 38 registered players who have not submitted a birth certificate. Lisa and I will be calling those parents remind them that they cannot play until birth certificates are sent in to Lisa or I.
- Soccerfest-Craig Goodfellow (for Cathy Goodfellow, who could not attend meeting)** Cathy has sent out 146 letters to local business around the community to ask of them donations for our Soccerfest. 29 from that list donated last year. Cathy submitted an amount of donations, donated so far, \$1444.80. Donations made are various prizes and certificates good towards goods or services to their businesses. We cleared up the motion for committee, from previous board meeting, to discuss giving out plaques to business who donates to our Region. Lisa and Tammy got together and discussed that issue. Our resolution is we have given Cathy permission to determine who will receive the plaques, and the kind of plaques they

- will receive. Cathy is putting that into her Soccerfest budget. We do have all of the meat donated for our Soccerfest this year. Not sure yet what kind of meat. Tammy is working on getting paperwork submitted to show donation. Cathy has also been asked to get together a "game plan" for Soccerfest. It is to show the board what it is she is planning, what she will need from the board, and to show how many volunteers will be needed to run a successful Soccerfest this season. Other various concerns and ideas were also discussed; we hope to clear up all issues by Cathy submitting her "game plan".
- **U K Soccer camp—Tammy Bresse**—not much discussed on this issue. Flyers have been mailed out by the UK Soccer camp last week to all of our players. We should let more parents know that this is a great soccer camp. We talked about how many is needed to run a camp, not sure, we will clear that up for the next meeting in June.
  - **Uniforms—Dennis Stoddard—(Rob Pierce not present)**—Dennis has informed us that a deposit in the amount of \$5,000 dollars was sent to company that we ordered our uniforms from this season.
  - **Goals Constuction—Tammy Bresse** The construction of the U8 division goals is almost completed. They are being bolted together and wheels set. The construction of the U14/16 size goals has been started. Everything is going as planned. **Donations for the construction of our goals is getting bigger. The local businesses who have donated to these goals being built are as follows: MCVAY MUFFLERS,** metal used to build and labor needed to build, **RED ROCK WELDING,** for the welding material needed to weld them together, **WESTERN INDUSTRIAL PARTS,** for the nuts and bolts and other misc. stuff needed to complete the goals. This has been a great effort by all involved in accomplishing this donation.
  - **Public Comment—Shannon Owens** she was concerned about the size of our uniforms ordered for the younger divisions. She wanted to know how come they are so big and if there was anything we could do for next year to change the size chart for better fitting uniforms for the younger divisions. We will work on getting better information together before ordering next years' uniforms. ----**Craig Goodfellow**---He brought to our attention a good idea to better our procedures of white slips being present on the field when players are playing on the field. His suggestion is to ask of each player registered to submit a picture of them within the last year, such as a school picture, etc. This would allow each coach and referee to identify each player before the start of a game. So no unregistered player could fill in for a player that is not able to be present on that game day. This has gone on in the past and we need to address this issue. So we are not held liable for that player if he or she becomes injured while playing in an AYSO game. We have asked Craig to put together a plan of action to make this happen. We could start it this year.
