Season 2007 Changes

This region is in the process of pulling together for the 2007 season. As it stands, this region **MUST** have the following board position in order to put the season on: Treasurer. Without this position being filled, the region will be unable to put on the 2007 season. Due to lack of volunteers, certain season changes will be implemented.

- 1) There will be no games during the week days, only two practices
 - a. Coaches may implement their own scrimmage games during the week with other teams within their division.
- 2) Games will be held only on Saturdays
- 3) There will not be a final playoff day
- 4) Formation of teams
 - a. AYSO is a fully volunteer organization and each team should have a parent, guardian or family friend step up to fulfill the below positions.
 - i. Coach
 - ii. Assistant Coach
 - iii. One certified referees (U6 division is excluded from this requirement) & two certified club linesmen
 1. Certified referees must attend the referee certification class & the two club linesmen must attend a club linesmen course.

2. In order for a team to qualify for a placement trophy, each team referee & two club linesmen must referee a set amount of games, which will be determined once the total number of team within a division has been determined.

- 5) This season the region will be accepting mail-in registrations for early registration with a post marked cut off date for returning players. Only two physical registrations will be held, specifically for new players to verify age with birth certificates, as well as for people without internet access.
- 6) The region will attempt to establish Rankings on all players to better balance teams.
- 7) Hyundai is no longer a national sponsor; therefore, we will no longer be receiving the coach's kits. The region is currently looking into costs associated with providing our own coach's kits.
- 8) As it stands, the region will be having a picture day, but no Soccerfest, due to that position not being filled. It has been set as an option on the calendar if someone does step forward to volunteer.
- 9) The region will once again have a mandatory meeting for all parents and coaches. These meetings have been changed so that each division will meet separately. Teams will receive their equipment at this point, but not their uniforms. Uniforms will be distributed on "Opening Day", July 28th, at which time we plan on distributing the candy for the fundraiser.
